### Ride Options For Everyone

Please check the rideboard on the club website for details and updates. Riders should carry water, food, and be prepared for flat tires. E-road bikes are welcome.

#### **Sunday, August 10, 2025 — Luther Pass MTB Technical Riding Practice**

Meet at the Luther Pass pullout for the Grass Lake Connector to the Tahoe Rim Trail. Google maps pin: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/EAK5kjgo99vVB4xS9>. Be ready to roll at 9:30am. We'll head up the Grass Lake Connector to the TRT and up towards Mr Toads, but this ride is just an out-n-back with no destination - the emphasis will be on practicing riding up the tricky bits and improving your skills. The trail has a wide variety of granite "problems", from beginner granite steps and ramps to big staircases. Afterwards there will be club snacks and drinks. Feel free to contact Jennie ([rideconsultant@altaalpina.org](mailto:rideconsultant@altaalpina.org)) if you have questions or want to carpool from Carson Valley.

#### **Sunday, August 17, 2025 — Boca Reservoir to Cisco Grove, Out and Back**

Meet at the Historic Boca Townsite (a dirt parking lot complete with an outhouse that you'll find online). To get there take Hirschdale road exit off of I-80, head about 1/3 of a mile north, right turn right after the railroad tracks off of Stampede Meadows Rd and look for Townsite sign. Be ready to ride at 9:30am. We will take a nice scenic route from Boca Reservoir to Cisco Grove via: Glenshire Dr., the beautiful Truckee River Bike Path, Donner Pass Rd. to Donner Lake State Park, South Shore Dr., up the Donner Pass, then left at Soda Springs for a loop of Serene Lakes, then down old 40 to Cisco Grove, and return for 72 miles round trip and 5200' of climbing. For a shorter ride you could turn around at Donner Pass (for 41 miles round trip) or at Serene Lakes (for 52 miles round trip). There will be water & restrooms stops at Donner State Park and a convenience store in Soda Springs at I-80. There's a short section of rough pavement so consider 28mm (or bigger) tires. It's a club weekend ride, so there will be snacks and drinks at the end. (For more see this Strava post: <https://www.strava.com/activities/2608145329>)

#### **Saturday, August 23, 2025 — Blackwood Canyon (Road Ride)**

Meet at the Palisades Ski area parking lot in Olympic Valley and be ready to ride at 9:00am. We will take the bike path up to Tahoe City and continue north on the bike path (or highway depending on traffic near the shoreline of Lake Tahoe). Then we'll turn west on Barker Pass Road and ride up Blackwood Canyon to the top of Barker Pass. We'll head back down and ride up Ward Creek Boulevard to the Sherwood lift of Alpine Meadows. Then head back to Olympic Valley the same way for a total of about 45 miles and about 3000' of climbing.

#### **Saturday, August 23, 2025 — Spoker Ride—CVTA Fund Raiser (MTB Ride)**

The Carson Valley Trails Association is hosting the "Jokers Wild" Spoker Ride at James Lee Park. Registration is \$40 per rider and includes a one year individual membership to CVTA (\$25 value) and one poker hand. Additional poker hands can be purchased for \$10. The event runs 9:00am to 2:00pm. The ride is approximately 10 miles on CVTA trails. #### **Sunday, September 14, 2025 — Third Highway Clean-up**

This is the third highway cleanup for the season. It's an easy way to help the club, the environment, and your community! We'll meet at Turtle Rock Park community building at 8:00am and break into groups to clean the highway roadside of litter. Please wear long pants and long sleeves for this. After the cleanup we'll regroup and set off to ride either Monitor or Ebbetts, whichever the group prefers. The more folks who show up, the easier, faster and more fun this goes, so if you're on the fence, c'mon out!

#### **Saturday, September 27, 2025 — Wrights Lake Road and Union Valley Reservoir Loop**

This is a beautiful lollipop ride on lightly travelled roads and good pavement around Union Valley Reservoir and thru the surrounding forests. Mileage for the ride is 62 with 7200 feet of climbing. We'll start out with a moderate climb up Wright's Lake road for 6 miles before turning onto (mostly) quiet forest service roads, passing Ice House Reservoir before looping around Union Valley Reservoir. New bike paths connecting the campgrounds on the east side of the reservoir will make for a pleasant tour around the lake. Water and restrooms should be available at several points along the ride (miles 13, 28, 43 and 49). Near the end of the tour, we'll have the option of riding up to Wright's Lake and back (4 miles total). Those wishing to avoid the 1300' climb over the first six miles can meet us at the intersection of Wright's Lake Road and FS 32. We'll meet at the dirt pullout on the right side of Wrights Lake road, just a couple hundred feet off of Highway 50. (<https://goo.gl/maps/JeW2iZWqfojGto0N8>).

## Board Meeting Minutes—August 4, 2025

Meeting called to order at 5:43pm

Minutes of the July meeting approved as presented. [Joseph | Bruce | Unanimous]

### 1. Monthly Status Reports:

- **Treasurer:** Bill reported the ytd income from membership fees, racing fees, and Death Ride Training Series. The current checking account balance is \$15,471.60. The Paypal balance is \$3,842.01. CDs are currently at \$11,110.33, \$12,167.32 and \$12,124.85. Total \$54,817.29. We are adding \$3000 to the amount invested longer term in CDs. Frank volunteered to work on a 2026 budget with different scenarios. He will distribute these to board members for email discussion and iteration prior to the next board meeting. All coordinators are encouraged to provide spending forecasts to Frank. Bill and Frank will work on updating the accounting and ongoing process for managing NICA team funds.
- **Membership:** There were four new members in July.
- **Weekend Rides:** Lyn couldn't lead a ride this weekend due to an injury. He hopes to be able to lead a ride again soon. Bill also cancelled his ride due to his injury and Rick is looking for someone to take over his upcoming ride. So we need two volunteers to come forward to lead weekend rides.
- **Weekly MTB Rides:** Chris reported that numbers are dropping off as the summer goes on and rides get more technical.
- **Social Media:** No report.
- **Newsletter:** Michael would like to get the newsletter out as soon as possible this month and September.
- **Website:** Greg is working with Twain to complete the updating of our library of rides. Dennis is moving forward with the rewrite of all

Paypal code. Michael and Jennie set up a new club Paypal account so that Dennis's work doesn't impact the existing account. Dennis and Michael are still working on configuring the new account. Paypal is problematic but the new APIs will address the critical issue with our membership renewal system in time for the next season. We need to explore other alternatives longer term.

- **Weekly Road Races:** Attendance has dropped off again for the second half of the season and we saw very low turnout for the Kingsbury time trial. Joseph will try to organize the end of season pizza party at Jethro's on September 4. The Pizza Factory in Minden will be the backup venue. Frank suggested promoting the pizza party via email and the newsletter. Joseph also reported that none of the first time racer coupons have been turned in yet.
  - **NICA Team:** No report.
  - **Death Ride Training Series:** Bruce reported that he hasn't yet received any feedback from the Chamber of Commerce in response to his email.
2. **Nominations for 2026:** Bruce confirmed that he is stepping down as president and Lyn confirmed he was stepping down as weekend ride coordinator. Recruiting nominees before the November general meeting is a top priority.
  3. **Annual Meeting:** It was agreed to move the meeting to a date after November 16, preferably November 18 or 19 at CVIC or the same location as last year. Michael will make the booking.
  4. **Upcoming Board Meetings:** Next board meeting will be Monday, September 8, 5:30pm, at the Carson Valley Swim Center. The October board meeting will be Wednesday October 1, 5:30pm, at the Carson Valley Swim Center.
