Tim Rowe Memorial Sweetwater Pass Ride: Full and Half Distance Options Sunday, October 2, 2022

We're once again closing out the ride season with our annual fall ride held in memory of Tim Rowe.

For the full distance (88 miles) plan to start around 9:30am from CG Bar and Pizza in Wellington, NV and ride to Bridgeport, CA back and forth over Sweetwater Pass. For the half distance (41 miles) start around noon and ride to the top of Sweetwater Pass and back to Wellington.

As usual, there will be a club rest stop on top of Sweetwater Pass. Participants will be on their own for food and water in Bridgeport if needed, so bring money for that. Upon returning to Wellington, the club will buy all participants pizza so don't eat too much beforehand! (You buy your own beverages.)

Parking at the start is limited, so for the full distance we'll meet at Lampe Park in Gardnerville at 8:30am to carpool. We'll roll out of Wellington at 9:30am so get there before 9:15am and be ready to roll. The whole ride is 88 miles, the half ride is about 41 miles.

As usual we'll park at CG Bar and the ride starts out of Wellington on the Wellington Cutoff (NV SR 829). The route to Bridgeport involves a very gentle and scenic climb to Sweetwater pass on NV state route 338. The rest stop will be located roughly half of the way to Bridgeport close to the highest point of the ride. We'll have water and snacks there.

This is followed by a descent to the East Walker River. We cross into California and follow the river, ride around Bridgeport Reservoir, and reach Bridgeport.

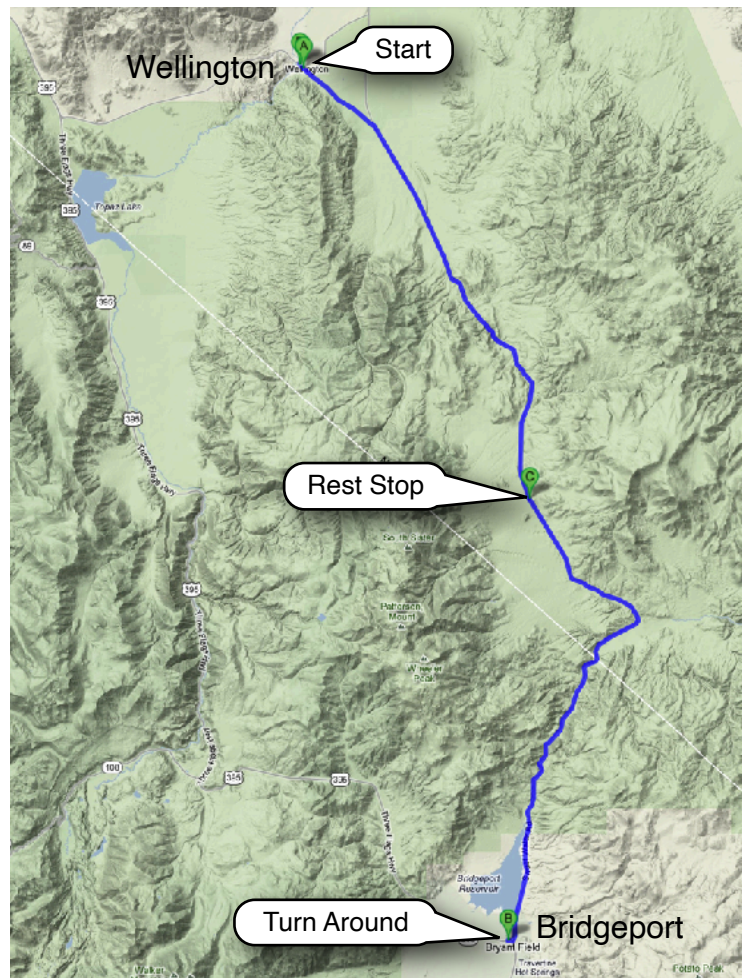
This is a great time of year to ride as the weather isn't too brutal and the roads are less busy with traffic. It's also a great time to see fellow club members and ride at a leisurely pace.

Board Meeting Minutes—August 31, 2022

Meeting held at Jethro's and by Zoom

Meeting called to order at 6:16 pm

Minutes of the August meeting approved as presented. [MichaelAllenUnanimous]

1. **Annual Meeting:** The board discussed alternative venues and budgets for the Annual Meeting. The bylaws require that the meeting be scheduled between October 1 and December 1. CVIC Hall is only available during the last week of November and the cost, including catering, would be under \$700. The alternative that was identified was renting the events room at Jethro's and having them cater the event. Jethro's quoted their rates for rental and per-person catering which worked out to about \$1400. After brainstorming alternatives, the board voted to rent the room at Jethro's but to order off the Jethro's menu for a budgeted cost of \$800 [BillBruceUnanimous]. [Ed Note: Jethro's later rejected this option and indicated that in order to rent their room we must pay the per-person catering amount.]
 2. **Challenge Survey:** Bruce summarized and distributed the results of the recent surveys of members and volunteers. Three distinct surveys were distributed: one for all the members who volunteered this year, one for the non-members who volunteered this year, and one for the members who didn't volunteer this year. Overall the majority of those surveyed were happy with the status quo. Non-members were almost unanimous in their enthusiasm for the Challenge. Most members who volunteered this year are available to help next year and numerous members who didn't volunteer this year are likely available next year. Michael, Bruce, and other board members will study the specific comments to identify possible improvements for the future.
 3. **Death Ride:** Bruce and Carlo met with the Alpine County Chamber to explore the possibility of working with the Chamber on future Death Ride events. Discussions included the possibility of partnering on future Death Ride Training Series. The Chamber followed up with a document suggesting that they may be interested in having the club manage significant portions of the event.
- The board discussed how we should respond to this opportunity.
4. **Monthly Status Reports:**
 - **Treasurer:** The current checking account balance is: \$20,604.36. The PayPal account balance is \$16,286.61.
 - **Membership:** There are 140 fully paid memberships including 24 family members.
 - **Weekend Rides:** Leon has reported a regular turnout for the rides he has lead. There was a really big turnout for the Pack Saddle Pass ride last weekend.
 - **Weekly MTB Rides:** Nine turned out for the backside of Toads ride.
 - **Social Media:** No report.
 - **Newsletter:** Michael will assemble and distribute the next newsletter as soon as details for the annual meeting are confirmed.
 - **Website:** Jim has been maintaining the home page. Board members should let Jim know if there are other pages that need to be updated.
 - **Clothing:** Inventory has been updated to reflect recent sales.
 - **Weekly Road Races:** Joseph reported that there was a tie for the D series. Chips are coming back with another 10 expected to come easily. Joseph will work on getting back the rest of the chips over the winter.
 - **Junior Team:** Junior team has had their first race. Drew has been posting on Facebook.
 - **Fall Century:** Dave has provided details for the newsletter.
 - **Adopt A Highway:** We'll do another if needed.
 - **Challenge:** 21 Jerseys sold. Still no invoices from USFS.
 - **Bike Advocacy:** No report.
 5. **Blue Zone Donation:** \$3000 donation. We need to participate in their event this weekend.
 6. **Next Meeting:** Jethro's on Oct 3 at 6 pm
